## PRESIDENT'S REPORT

OUR 2023 – 2024 SEASON HAS SOLIDIFIED OUR POST COVID RE-EMERGENCE WITH A BALANCE BETWEEN OUR FUNDAMENTAL ELEMENTS OF COMMUNITY AND COMPETITIVE WATER POLO.

In the realm of water polo, we have embarked on another competitive year with a number of Surge teams representing across WPV State league competitions for autumn, winter and summer seasons. A source of great pride over these seasons is seeing the continued growth of our players and watching them display our club values of inclusion, friendship and sportsmanship. WPV have now noted on multiple occasions the continued improvement in skill they have seen from our players. This is primarily due to the ongoing support and dedication from one of most dedicated coaches Chloe Lim.

Our accomplishments in the water reached the pinnacle, with Melbourne Surge delivering and winning The Rainbow Cup in February 2024, our Summer Grudge Match tournament. Melbourne Surge also took our water polo prowess onto the global stage placing 4th at The Gay Games hosted in Guadalajara, Mexico in November 2023.
